Brookside Capital Project Progress Report

It has been a very busy summer with projects underway at Brookside!

- **FLOORING** the flooring installation project on the lower level is complete! Fellowship Hall, the classrooms, bathrooms, and hallway have a new brighter look to them. North Ridge completed the asbestos mitigation and supplied clean air test results following the tile removal. While the mastic grinding created a lot of dust, the material in the mastic was tested and was not contaminated. Titan Cleaning will be doing a final sweep of the construction dust on Tuesday, July 16th and then all furnishings can be moved back into the rooms for full access by the end of the week. Note that the kitchen flooring was tabled for future discussion on investment due to cost measures that would have exceeded the agreed-upon budget amounts for this project. Removal of the kitchen flooring would have required Brookside to conform to current code on the equipment in the kitchen. A new hood and ventilation system would have been required. We will discuss investment in this segment of the project in future phases. The health department may put pressure on this during our next review.
- ROOF/GUTTERS/DOWNSPOUTS Custom Slate and Copper is well underway with the roofing repairs on the historic sections of the building. Several courses of

slate are being removed to put down ice and water shield, then the slate is placed back. All copper gutters, valleys, and downspouts are being refreshed with new copper. Then the chimneys will be repointed as needed. As of the end of the week, the Carriage House where the Thrift Shop operates is nearly complete, and work has started on the Manning House section. We are midway through the project and will be doing a "check-in" with LCHIP this week. The copper is bright and shiny at this stage but will change in appearance over time.

- **PARKING LOT** The catch basins in two areas of the parking lot were repointed in response to a sinkhole. Those repairs and patching of the asphalt were completed last month, but the cones remained up while the asphalt cured. The parking lot remains on a "watch list" and we have started to collect contractor quotes for future replacement.
- **COTTAGE** The cottage has been refreshed with paint and repairs to windows, gutters, and the bathtub. Thanks to the success of the Thrift Shop operations and sales revenue, Brookside was able to fund the repairs without an impact on the budget. The results of this investment make the cottage an income-generating section of the building where the IINE has added it to their lease. The cottage income will help to fund our new Sexton hire. Thank you to all of the incredibly dedicated Thrift Shop volunteers who made this possible from Thrift Shop operating income.
