Last Sunday, in our scripture story, Jesus came home to Nazareth. He read a passage from the Prophet Isaiah and allowed the congregation to ponder its meaning for themselves. This Sunday, he remains in the same hometown synagogue with another message. Still referring to prophets of old, he speaks to his childhood community of God's healing powerful Spirit; and makes a clear statement that we cannot hold expectations of what and how God heals. With no expectations, he teaches us to create space for the Holy Spirit.

His message causes fury in his congregation. They expect him to

heal them just as he healed Gentiles in Capernaum. But he holds fast to the truth of his own power: God heals the world.

We are charged this week, to trust that God's works are beyond our personal expectations. Keep praying!

Kids will remain in church so we can worship together before I begin my two-month sabbatical. Rev. Doug Brendel, who is covering during the Sabbatical, will join us for worship and Holy Communion.

Women's Retreat July 7-9 Adelyrood Retreat & Conference Center, Byfield, MA

Rev. Laura has found a wonderfully affordable location for a women's retreat just 45 minutes south of Manchester. One or two-night stays are available. We are planning to arrive on Monday, July 7 at 11 am, and spend the afternoon enjoying the grounds. Room check-in is at 3 pm. Check-out is Wednesday by 11 am. A shared room with 2 beds would be \$137/per person, per night which includes 3 full meals, snacks, coffee, and tea. A private room is \$164/night.

It's a beautiful 14-acre campus developed in the early 20th century by landscape architect and early member of the Society of the Companions of the Holy Cross, Deaconess Mary Potter. Her design vision of "indigenous plantings, a naturalized setting and simplicity" remains evident in the gardens and grounds. Features include paths through five wooded acres, a guided meditation walk called the "Stations of Creation," a stone labyrinth, and many gardens. Bicycling and the beach are close by. A deposit is required to hold the dates. If


